AMS Timeline and BWT

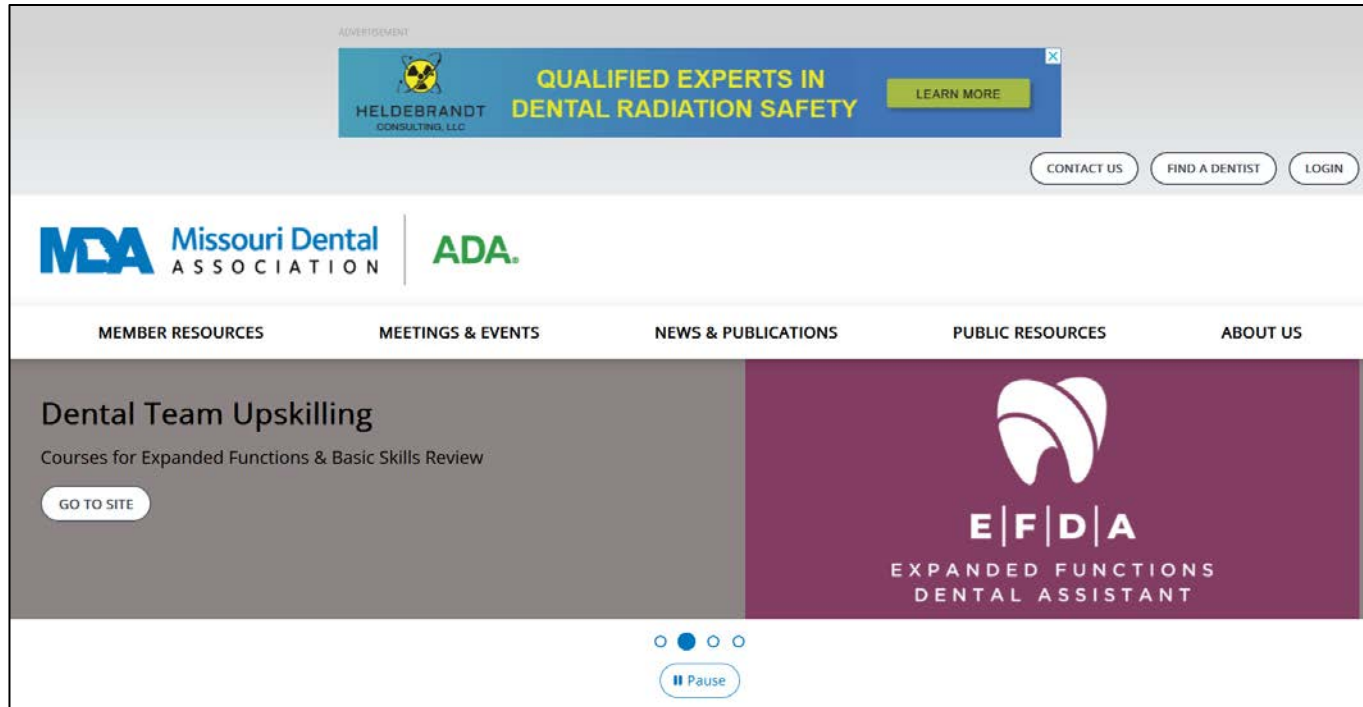
- Sitefinity CMS will remain online throughout the AMS launch
- AMS launch on Tuesday, September 10
- Blackout Week
 - Tuesday, September 3 through Monday, September 9
 - ***BWT Login will be available during Blackout Week***
 - No changes to Aptify Users or Lists during this period
- Sites will be switched to AMS Login on September 10

New Site Login Process

New Site Login Process Overview

- What's the Same?
 - Users can login from Login button or click on locked content link
 - Welcome message once logged into society Web site
 - Locking content in Sitefinity CMS
 - Pages, documents and files
- What's New?
 - New AMS login form
 - Email address as username
 - For society staff, different than Tripartite username

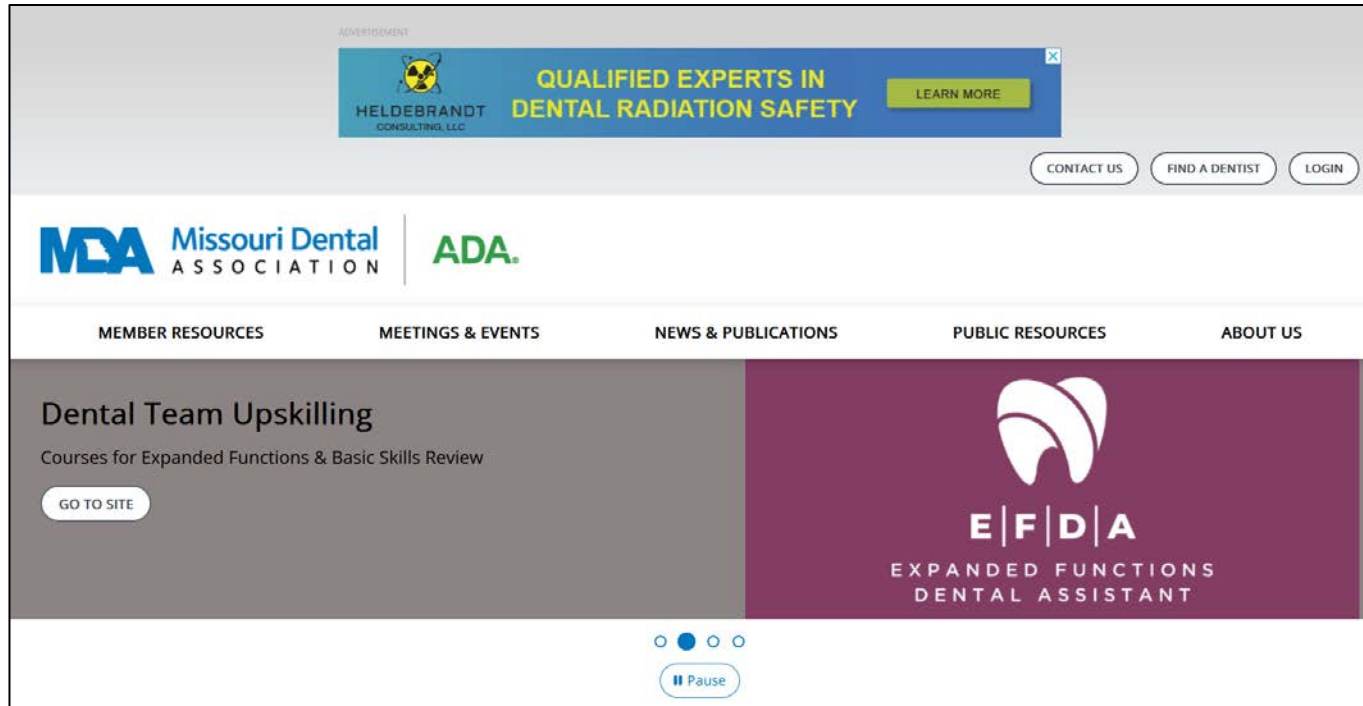

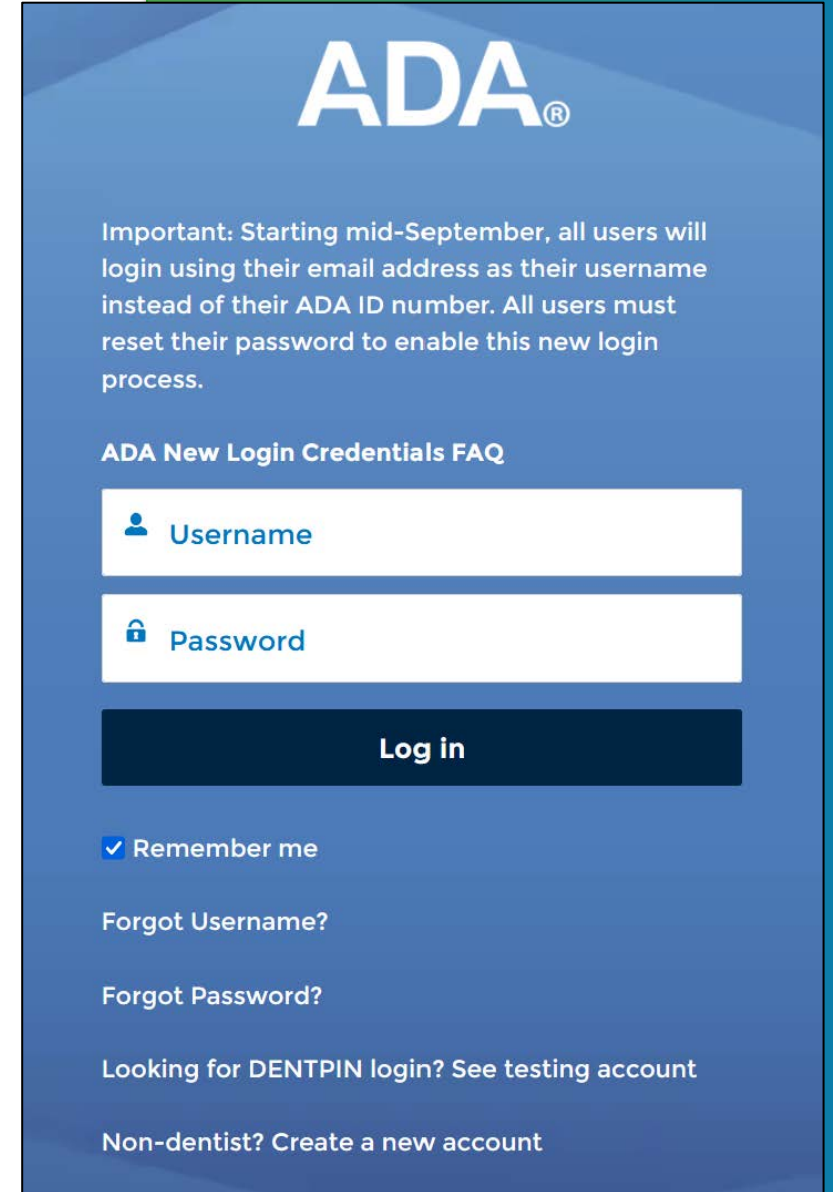

- What's the Same?
 - Members Only access automatically assigned
 - Student access assigned by site
- What's New?
 - Management of access with Permissions as compared to Lists
 - Using AMS Community Groups and Permission Levels
 - Aptify List **settings** will be migrated to the AMS

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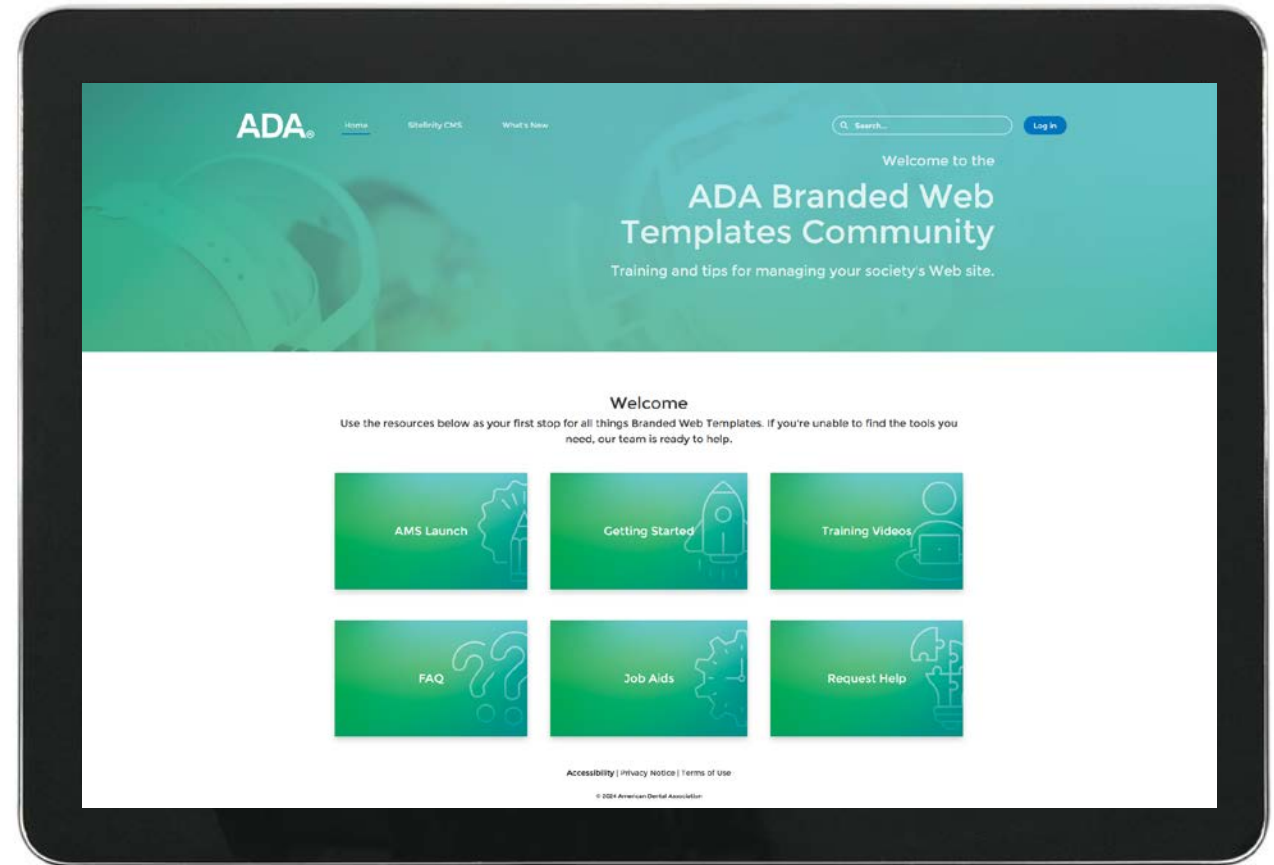
Required Site Content Changes

- Societies responsible for updates to their own site links
- Links to Dues Page, Event Registration, et. al.
 - File with link mapping by society:

- Get Ahead of Changes
 - Identify and Make Changes, Save in Draft Mode, Publish on Launch

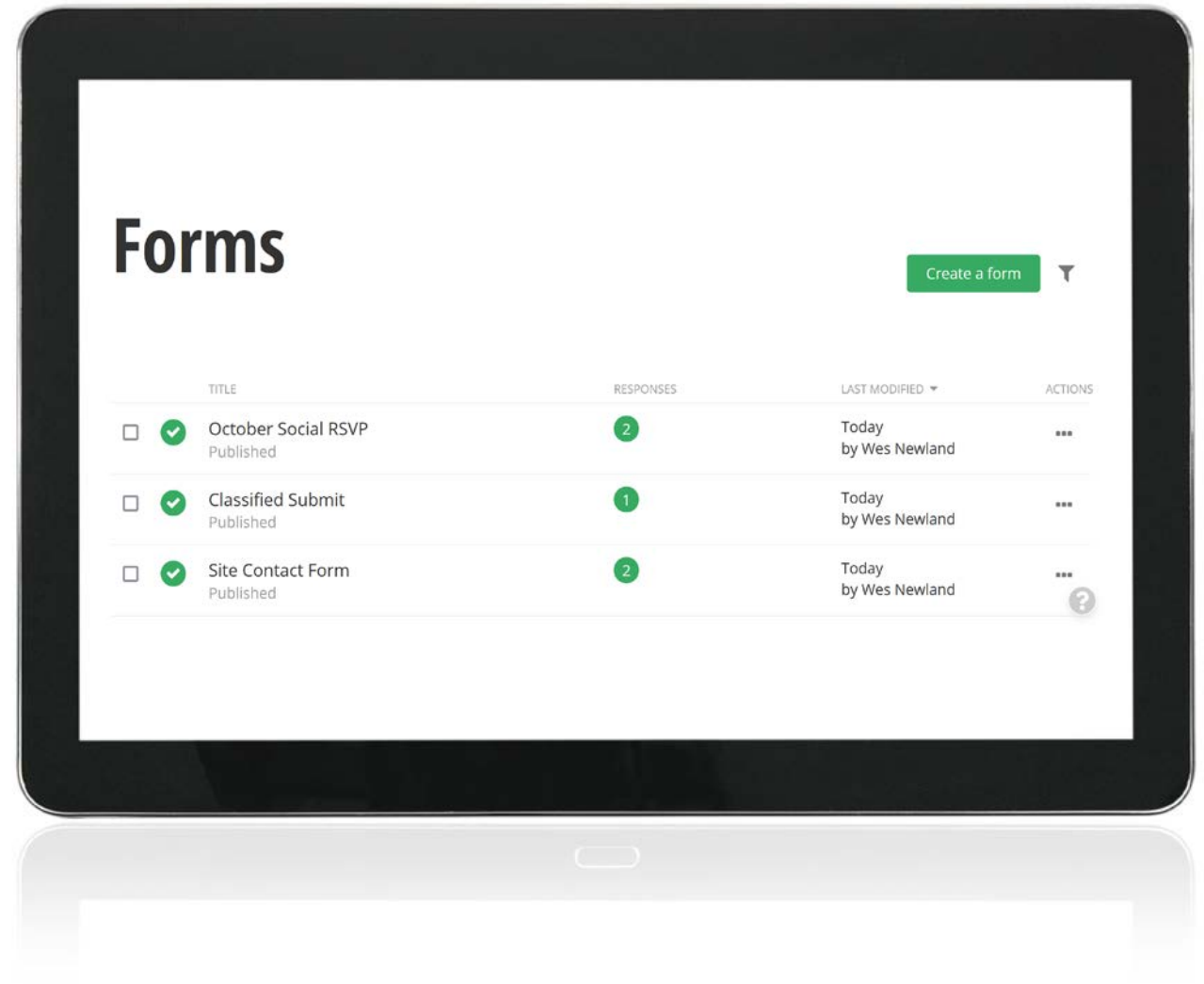
